It particularly serves to meet the need for a professional qualification on the under-graduate level in project management.

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

A Higher Certificate, or at least a Senior Certificate ('matric' or international equivalent) coupled with relevant management experience and/or additional courses for the purpose of recognition of prior learning (RPL). For the purpose of RPL assessment, all relevant information and documentation, including a detailed curriculum vitae (particularly describing the applicant's work experience) must be submitted to the Registrar (Academic). This category is designed to provide opportunities to those who meet the following criteria:

- Have completed at least the National Senior Certificate (or international equivalent).
- Have been employed or vocationally active in the community for at least two years since earning the Senior Certificate.
- 3. Have gained relevant management experience in the workplace, holding a position of authority and responsibility.
- 4. Have completed relevant credible courses related to the required competencies at credible institutions.

Applicants must generally comply with at least 1) to 3) above, but evidence related to 4) will also contribute significantly to a favorable outcome and may obviate the need for 3). Where an applicant has been identified by his or her employer as having leadership potential resulting from Human Resources career-path tracking, it is sufficient for him or her to comply only with 1) and 3) above.

For the purpose of RPL assessment, all relevant information and documentation, including a detailed curriculum vitae (particularly describing the applicant's substantial work experience) must be submitted to the Registrar (Academic). This is designed to provide opportunities to those who meet the following criteria:

- 1. Have completed at least the National Senior Certificate (or international equivalent).
- 2. Have been employed or active in the community for at least eight years since leaving secondary school.
- 3. Have gained substantial management experience in the workplace, holding a position of authority and responsibility.
- Have successfully completed the foundational module ACα (Project Management: Perspective, Planning and Implementation) or PM Short Course (Project Management: Perspective, Planning and Implementation) at Cranefield College.
- 5. Have completed other courses related to the required competencies at credible institutions.

Applicants must generally comply with at least 1) to 5) above, but evidence related to 5) will also contribute significantly to RPL. Where an applicant has been identified by his or her employer as having leadership potential resulting from Human Resources career-path tracking, it is sufficient for him or her to comply only with 1), 2) and 4) above. In evaluating students for RPL purposes, current competencies in the field of Project Management that have been acquired by experiential learning through related studies and/or experience will be closely assessed.

Submission of Documents:

- 1. Submit certified copies of your highest qualifications.
- 2. Submit a curriculum vitae, which must reflect all your qualifications and the latest grades received.
- 3. The Admissions Committee may, however, require you to provide certified copies relating to all courses/programmes attended at any other institution, prior to approving admission to the learning programme involved.

BACHELOR OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (BBA)



ACADEMIC QUALIFICATIONS OVERVIEW

PURPOSE OF THE BBA DEGREE

The purpose of the Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) in Project and Supply Chain Management is to master the essentials of organisational value chain management in the prevailing fourth industrial revolution (Industry 4.0 or 4IR). These essentials include general management, business management, project management, programme management, and supply chain management. The BBA's distance learning structure allows for maximum flexibility in terms of when and where to study and is designed to meet the needs of working students. The BBA degree is accredited at NQF Level 7 (360 credits).

Momentous changes are occurring in the 4IR environment, and business administration is now more than ever a vibrant and extremely valuable field of study. In the Cranefield BBA programme, students are extensively trained in the 4IR general management functions of leading, creating, implementing and improving. Business management aspects covered include functional management aspects such as finance, operations, marketing, logistics, and human resources that support programme-managed supply chain and project portfolios leading to optimal organisational improvement and performance.

BBA graduates are equipped to be leaders in the 4IR economy but will also have gained a solid foundation for postgraduate studies, through which they could continue to achieve greater heights in terms of developing their expertise. Qualifying students who further their studies through Cranefield may next enrol for the Postgraduate Diploma in Programme Management (completed part-time in nine months) and thereafter for the Master of Commerce in Programme Management (completed part-time in two years, depending on module choices and personal progress). Exceptional students may later in their careers progress all the way to the Cranefield PhD in Commerce and Administration, which signifies the highest level of attainment.

- Understand the fundamentals of commercial and contract law in order to add value to corporate, business and operations strategy and risk management.
- Reflect on and optimally apply the 4IR management functions of leading, creating, implementing, and improving to achieve organisational performance.
- Grasp the important role played by functional departments in providing supportive resources to cross-functional supply chain and project portfolios of the 4IR organisational value chain.
- Understand how virtual networks of partners are utilised collaboratively to perform non-core activities in business processes of 4IR organisations.
- Distinguish between marketing and logistics and grasp the important relationship that exists be-tween these functional organisational departments.

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

Cranefield's Postgraduate Diploma in Programme Management. Candidates who hold degrees or diplomas obtained from other recognized academic institutions and have relevant experience, may also apply. All relevant information and documentation, including a detailed curriculum vitae and the applicant's work experience, must be submitted to the Registrar (Academic). Hence, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Completion of Cranefield's Postgraduate Diploma in Programme Management, or any NQF Level 8 or higher qualification recognised by the Admissions Committee as being equivalent, is a prerequisite for admission.
- An 'equivalent qualification' means any NQF level 8 or higher qualification with similar content as Cranefield's Postgraduate Diploma.
- 3. If certain subjects were not sufficiently covered in the 'equivalent qualification', relevant modules from the Postgraduate Diploma learning programme will have to be undertaken in addition to those of the Master's learning programme.
- 4. A minimum average of 63% is required for the Postgraduate Diploma.
- 5. Every case will be evaluated on its own merits.

Submission of Documents:

- 1. Submit certified copies of your highest academic qualifications.
- 2. Submit a curriculum vitae, which must reflect all your qualifications and the latest grades received.
- The Admissions Committee may, however, require you to provide certified copies relating to all courses/programmes attended at any other institution, prior to approving admission to the learning programme involved.

DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY DEGREE (PhD)

The Doctor of Philosophy degree is a research degree, awarded on the basis of a doctoral thesis.

ACCREDITATION

The Cranefield Doctor of Philosophy degree is accredited at NQF level 10, with 360 credits, as reflected on the SAQA (South African Qualifications Authority) website.

The Cranefield PhD is accredited by the Council on Higher Education NQF level 10, with 360 credits, and registered by the Department of Higher Education and Training.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

When considering an application for registration for the PhD degree, the Doctoral Selection Committee shall be guided by the following admission requirements:

- · An appropriate master's degree; or
- Recognition of prior learning (RPL) that results in a level of research and subject-matter competencies that may be regarded as comparable to master's level and sufficient to complete doctoral studies successfully. The appropriate level could, for instance, be evidenced by research articles published in refereed journals. Provision above must be read with existing Cranefield RPL policies.

A person shall not be admitted as a candidate for the degree unless he or she:

- is a graduate of the College or of any other Higher Education Institution recognised by the Doctoral Selection Committee, holding at least a master's degree or equivalent qualification; or
- Has, in any other appropriate manner, attained a level of competence which, in the assessment of the Doctoral Selection Committee, and on the recommendation of the Registrar (Academic), is sufficient for the purpose of admission as a candidate for the PhD degree.

APPLICATION PROCESS

1. REGISTRATION FOR THE PHD

Applications for registration must be submitted to the Registrar (Academic). Any application of a candidate who did not obtain his or her previous qualifications from Cranefield College must be accompanied by an original statement from the academic institution where the qualifications were obtained.

Included in the statement

- · The statement must indicate the marks or symbols obtained for all successfully completed courses/Programmes.
- · Candidates must not submit original degree certificates.
- · Only certified copies of original certificates will be accepted.
- Candidates must, with their application for registration, also submit a comprehensive portfolio of evidence with regard to their technical knowledge and skills application in project and programme management, their managerial experience in project and programme management leadership, and their contextual experience in portfolio and programme management.

2. EVALUATION OF QUALIFICATIONS

- Upon receipt of a candidate's application and academic records (in respect of qualifications not obtained at Cranefield), the Doctoral Selection Committee will decide whether the candidate meets the minimum requirements prescribed for registration.
- Doctoral candidates are expected to make suggestions regarding the specific topic within the area of study in which they
 would like to conduct research.
